

Summer Fellow – Private Equity

Role:

The Summer Intern's role will be to work with the Private Equity investment team of KAUST Investment Management Company (KIMC). Some of the specific project work may include the following:

- Review/analysis of investment opportunities by sub-sector (e.g. Buyouts, Venture Capital, etc.) and by geography.
- Review offering memoranda and develop database for tracking incoming deal opportunities.
- Assist in the development of internal performance/portfolio monitoring reports for the private equity portfolio.

The intern will be responsible for sourcing and analyzing appropriate information in relation to the different private equity sectors that the portfolio is currently invested in/is prospectively looking at, as well as organizing them in an efficient way for further analysis and decision making. The intern will participate in internal meetings and discussions related to asset allocation and investment decisions.

(Please note that, due to the flexible needs of the Private Equity asset-class function, specific project work may change somewhat over time from the work listed above. The Managing Director, Private Equity, will discuss proposed project work with the Summer Intern before he/she accepts the job.)

Requirements: Solid understanding of the private equity industry and capital markets. Good knowledge of Microsoft Excel, excellent research capabilities and good communication skills.
